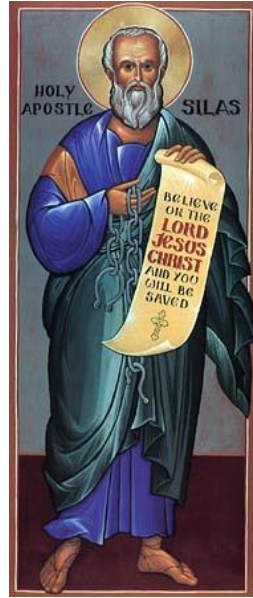

Who are the Holy Apostles Silas and Silvanus and those with them?

The holy, glorious, all-laudable Apostle Silas is numbered among the Seventy Apostles, or disciples of the Savior. As a prophet and missionary, St. Silas went with Sts. Paul and Barnabas from Antioch to Jerusalem to settle the dispute among believers there about circumcision. The Holy Apostle Silvanus preached the Word of God together with both the Apostles Peter and Paul. In his First Epistle, the holy Apostle Peter makes mention of him: "By Silvanus, a faithful brother to you, as I suppose, I have written briefly..." (1 Peter 5:12). After a girl possessed with a spirit of divination was healed, he and Paul were imprisoned (Acts 16:16-39). Following this he traveled with St. Paul through Asia and Macedonia and was eventually made Bishop of Corinth. He died there a martyr about 50 AD, having undergone many sorrows and misfortunes for the Lord's sake. The Church remembers St. Silas on July 30 with Apostles Silvanus, Crescens, Epenetus and Andronicu.



O faithful, let us praise with hymns the choir of the seventy disciples of Christ. They have taught us all to worship the undivided Trinity, for they are divine lamps of the Faith.
