Excerpt from *Christ Our Pascha*

Structure of the Catechism

Part Two of the Catechism develops the liturgical understanding of Christ's Passover, based upon the words of Christ's institution of the Eucharist at the Mystical Supper [Last Supper] and as cited by the Anaphora. This is the Eucharistic heart from which proceed all the cycles of the Church's liturgical prayer (daily, weekly, yearly); from which flow the Holy Mysteries on their celebration; and from which spiritual life is born, and devotion flourishes. Eternal Memory – Vichnaya Pamyat

Who is Holy Priest- Martyr Anthimus, Bishop of Nicomedia?

Anthimus was a priest and bishop of Nicomedia, the same city which was chief residence of Emperor Diocletian. He was known for his virtues and his preaching. In Bithynia, he and his companions, were martyrs in the persecution by the pagan Emperor Diocletian. In fact, a whole crowd followed him as he received the glory of martyrdom. For some of his companions, a judge ordered beheading by the sword, some were burned up by fire, and some were put in boats and drowned at sea. Anthimus was to be drowned in the river Tiber but an angel rescued him. He then was beheaded in the year 303 AD.

You protected your flock with your blood, not fearing your adversaries. Now you rejoice in heaven standing before the throne. Glory to Christ who has strengthened you; glory to your courage; glory to your endurance, O holy Hieromartyr Anthimus!
