Excerpt from *Christ Our Pascha*

Sin is, first of all, a person's state that manifests itself in actions, and a sinful deed is the conscious and voluntary violation of God's commandment. Violation of even one of God's commandments is a violation of all of God's Law. "For whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become accountable (guilty) for all of it. For he who said, 'You shall not commit adultery,' also said 'You shall not murder.' Now if you do not commit adultery but if you murder, you have become transgressor of law" (Jas2:10-11). As one illness can cause another, so one soon leads to another. Saint John of Damascus emphasizes that there are eight evil "thoughts" (in Greek, *logismoi*), that give rise to sin: gluttony, lust, avarice (love of money), melancholy, anger, acedia (despondency), vain glory and pride. We call them the capital sins as they are the root of all other sinful acts. (# 758)

Who is Holy Venerable-Martyr Anastasia?

Martyr Anastasia the Roman lost her parents in infancy, and was reared by Sophia, the abbess of a women's monastery, who raised the child in fervent faith. The persecution of Christians by emperor Decius (249-251) began at that time. The city administrator Probus, on the orders of the emperor, commanded that Anastasia be brought to him. Blessed by her abbess to suffer for Christ, the young martyr Anastasia humbly came out to meet the armed soldiers. Seeing her youth and beauty, Probus first attempted flattery to make her deny Christ. "Why waste your youth, deprived of pleasure? What is there to gain by enduring tortures and death for the Crucified? Worship our gods, marry a handsome husband, and live in glory and honor." She replied, "My spouse, my riches, my life and my happiness are my Lord Jesus Christ, and you will not turn me away from Him by your deceit!" Probus subjected Anastasia to fierce tortures. The holy martyr bravely endured them, glorifying and praising the Lord. In anger the torturers cut out her tongue. The people, seeing the inhuman and disgusting treatment of the saint, became indignant, and the ruler was compelled to end the tortures by beheading her and so, Saint Anastasia received the crown of martyrdom. Her body was thrown out to be eaten by wild animals, but the Lord did not permit her holy relics to be dishonored. At the command of an angel, Abbess Sophia found the saint's mutilated body and with the help of two Christians, buried her in the earth.
