

## Who are Holy Martyrs Photius & Anicetas?

Emperor Diocletian once visited the city of Nicomedia planning to exterminate the Christians. When the merciless torture of Christians began, St. Anicetas, a high ranking official of the city, boldly confessed before the emperor his faith in Christ the Lord. Anicetas also denounced idols as deaf & dumb stones unworthy of worship by a rational man. The emperor ordered his tongue to be severed but Anicetas, by the power of God, continued to speak. A lion was released against him but the lion cuddled him. At that moment the temple of Hercules collapsed. Photius, a kinsman of Anicetas, seeing the miracles & endurance of Anicetas, kissed him, declared himself a Christian & cried out to the emperor: " O idolator, be ashamed, your gods are nothingness!" The emperor ordered Anicetas immediately be beheaded. However, the executioner, raising his hand against holy Photius, struck himself with the sword and died. After prolonged tortures, both Anicetas and Photius were cast into prison where they languished for three years. Then they were brought out, a fire was lighted in an enormous furnace and they cast them into the fire. Many other Christians, men, women and children, willingly followed them into the fire. From the fire was heard the prayer of the Christians who were praising God for the death of martyrdom. They all suffered about the year 305 A.D. Saint Anicetas and Saint Photius are invoked in the prayers in the Sacrament of Anointing with Oil [Holy Unction] and in the Blessing of Water.
