Who is Holy Great Martyr Euphemia?

Euphemia was the daughter Christians senator Philophronos & Theodosia. Chalcedon governor Priscus commanded all offer sacrifice at a pagan festival, threatening torments if not there. During the pagan festival, 49 Christians, including young Euphemia, were hidden in one house, secretly attending services. Soon discovered, they were tried before governor. For 19 days they were tortured, but none wavered in their faith. The governor then sent them to the Roman Emperor Diocletian, keeping the young virgin Euphemia, hoping that she would not remain strong if alone. Praying that Jesus strengthen her, she was urged to recant her faith. Refusing, she was tied to a wheel with sharp knives, which cut her body. Praying



aloud, the wheel stopped & couldn't be budged by the executioners. An Angel removed Euphemia from the wheel & healed her wounds. The Saint gave thanks to the Lord. Two soldiers, Victor and Sosthenes, were ordered to put her in a red-hot oven, but seeing two fearsome Angels in the flames, they refused obey & boldly proclaimed they too were Christians. Sent to be eaten by wild beasts, they cried out for mercy, asking that the Lord would receive them into the Heavenly Kingdom. A heavenly Voice answered their cries, they entered into eternal life & the beasts never touched their bodies. Euphemia, cast into the fire by other soldiers, emerged unharmed after many other tortures and torments. A pit was filled with knives, and covered over with earth and grass, but Euphemia easily passed over with no harm. Sentenced to be devoured by wild beasts at the circus, she prayed to be worthy to die a violent death but none of the beasts attacked her. Finally, a she-bear gave her a small wound on the leg, from which came blood, & immediately the holy Great Martyr Euphemia died in 304 AD. During an earthquake, her parents were able to take her body & bury it near Chalcedon. A majestic church was later built over her grave; there the 4th Ecumenical Council took place in 451 A.D. Saint Euphemia miraculously confirmed the Orthodox confession, exposing the Monophysite heresy. In 617 AD her holy relics were transferred to Constantinople. During the Iconoclast heresy, her relics were thrown into the sea but sailors recovered them, first taken to the Island of Lemnos, and in the year 796 A.D. they were returned to Constantinople.
