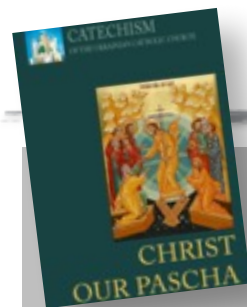

Excerpt from *Christ Our Pascha*

Apostolic Tradition

Christ entrusts the word of Revelation to his apostles: "... for the words that you [Father] gave to me I have given to them, and they have received them... I have given them your word" (*Jn 17:8, 14*). The Church continues the apostolic mission in the transmission of God's Revelation. She is called to preach and to interpret it. To fill this, Christ gave his Church the Holy Spirit, who leads her into all truth (see *Jn 16:13*). The Church transmits God's Revelation in two ways: *orally* - "by the apostles who, by their oral preaching, by example, and by observances handed on what they had received from the lips of Christ, from living with him, and from what he did, or what they had learned through the prompting of the Holy Spirit;" and *in writing* - "by those apostles and apostolic men who under the inspiration of the same Holy Spirit committed the message of salvation to writing." Who is Venerable Mother Parasceva of Ternovo?

Venerable Mother Parasceva was born in Epivat (Thrace; [Byzantium](#), near Constantinople) in 11th century, She was of noble origin. Her pious parents taught her as a child the words of the Gospel which say that everyone who wants to follow the Lord Jesus must give up everything. When her parents died, she gave up the world for the "desert" while still young in years. First for five years she dedicated her life entirely to God through [prayer](#) and [fasting](#). Then she went to the Holy Land (Palestine) and undertook [ascetic](#) struggles in the desert of Jordan. In her old age, she returned to Constantinople to the Church of Holy Theotokosin Blaherna to venerate the miraculous icon of the Mother of God. Two centuries after her death (1238 A.D.), the Bulgarian emperor John Asen decided to move St. Parasceva's relics from Epivat, which then was under the Crusader's control, to Ternovo, the capital of Bulgaria. She is honored in Romania as Parascheva, and in Serbia and Macedonia as Petka. She is also distinguished from other saints of the same name with the descriptions "the New" or "the Young." Her holy [relics](#) are in the Metropolitan Cathedral Church, Iași, Romania. She is the patron saint of the Romanian region of Moldova and Romanians generally have great esteem towards her.
