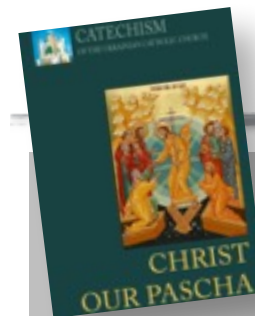
### Парафіяльні Оголошення.

### Apostolic Tradition

Christ chooses his apostles and sends them to preach the Word: “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations...teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you” (Mt 28: 19-20). Having received the commission of Christ’s Ascension and then receiving the power of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost, the apostles began to preach Christ and witness to him: “This Jesus God raised up, and of that all of us are witnesses” (Acts 2:32). Following the example of Christ the Teacher, the apostles transmit his Gospel to their disciples through the living word of preaching, calling upon all to preserve it; “Guard the good treasure entrusted to you, with the help of the Holy Spirit living within us (2 Tm 1:14). ## *Who is Venerable Father Hilarion the Great?*

Hilarion was born in 291 in the Palestinian village of Tabatha. While studying in Alexandria, he was baptized a Christian. After learning of the angelic life of Saint Anthony the Great, Hilarion went to meet him, desiring to study with him and learn what is pleasing to God. Hilarion soon returned home to find his parents had died. He distributed his family's inheritance to the poor and set out into the desert surrounding the city of Maium. There the devil tormented him with impure temptations and tried to frighten him with phantoms and apparitions. During prayer Saint Hilarion heard children crying, women wailing, the roaring of lions and other wild beasts. The monk realized the demons caused these terrors to drive him away from the wilderness, but he overcame his fear with the help of fervent prayer. Once, robbers fell upon Saint Hilarion, and he persuaded them to forsake their life of crime through the power of his words. Soon all of Palestine learned about the holy ascetic. The Lord granted to the saint the power to cast out unclean spirits and he loosed the bonds of many afflicted. The sick came for healing, and the monk cured them free of charge, saying that the grace of God is not for sale. Many came to Saint Hilarion wanting to save their soul under his guidance. With his blessing, monasteries began to spring up throughout Palestine. About seven years before his death (+ 371-372) Saint Hilarion moved back to Cyprus, where the ascetic lived in a solitary place until the Lord summoned him to Himself.
