Excerpt from *Christ Our Pascha*

Faithfulness to Tradition

The unbroken continuity of Tradition is realized in the liturgical life of the Church, and in the teaching of the Holy Fathers, whose witness to the Truth is based not on human recollections, but on the living an uninterrupted experience of the Holy Spirit. The constancy of this experience within the Christian community is the safeguard of our faithfulness to the apostles' teaching, to the heritage of the Holy Fathers, and to the teaching of the Church, which strengthens our hope in the promise of the coming age. Faithfulness to Tradition is faithfulness to new life in Christ, which has been transmitted by the Holy Spirit to the apostles, and from them to the bishops, the presbyters, the deacons, and all the faithful. Who is Holy Martyr Clement, Pope of Rome?

St. Clement of Rome was our fourth Pope. St. Irenaeus, a Father of the Early Church, said that Clement "saw the blessed Apostles and conversed with them, and had yet ringing in his ears the preaching of the Apostles and had their tradition before his eyes, and not he only for many were then surviving who had been taught by the Apostles ". Epiphanius said Clement was a contemporary of Peter & Paul. His service as Bishop of Rome was probably from about 92-101 A.D. Tradition says he was ordained by St. Peter and acted as an auxiliary bishop to Linus and Anacletus, his predecessors in the papal chair. About 110 A.D. Clement was sentenced to a martyr's death in the arena by the Emperor Trajan. According to a fourth century story, Trajan had banished the pope to the Crimea in the southern Ukraine because of his success in evangelization, where he satisfied the thirst of two thousand Christian confessors by a miracle. People of the country were converted & seventy-five churches built. Frustrated, Trajan ordered Clement be thrown into the sea with an iron anchor. Even after his martyrdom he had an impact because the tide receded two miles every year, revealing a divinely built shrine containing the martyr's bones. Clement's papal letter to the Corinthians was written about 80 A.D. in an effort to restore peace to the Church at Corinth, Greece which had broken into factions and was intent upon firing some of their presbyters.
