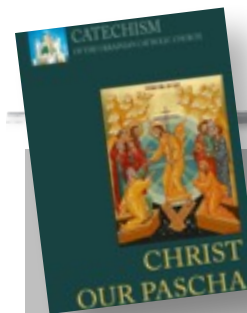

Excerpt from *Christ Our Pascha*

Faithfulness to Tradition

The first Christian communities preserved and transmitted the apostolic teaching; they preached the word of God and lived by it (see Phil 2:11), continually abiding in “the apostles’ teaching and fellowship, [devoting themselves] to the breaking of the bread and the prayers” (Acts 2:42). Especially in the “breaking of the bread”, Christians recognized the fulfillment of the Gospel and the presence of Christ among them (see Lk 24:31). At the same time, they announced the arrival of the coming age. They did so while living in this world, yet not being “of this world” (see Jn 15:19, 17:14). These words can be fully applied to the Church today, which maintains within herself the Apostolic Tradition. Following the example of Peter, the Church unceasingly calls all people to repentance and baptism, by which they receive the gift of the Holy Spirit: “For the promise is for you, for your children and for all who are far away, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to him” (Acts 2:39). The faithful receive a foretaste of these events and of the coming of the kingdom God in the most Holy Eucharist, where the encounter and communion of God and humankind is realized. This is the content of Tradition by which the Church lived in apostolic times, I would she list today, and by which you believe in the age to come. (#36)

Парафіяльні Оголошення.

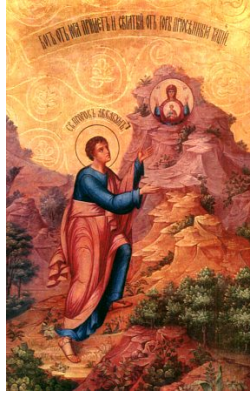

Who is Holy Prophet Habakkuk?

The Holy Prophet Habakkuk (Avvakum), one of the 12 Minor Prophets, was descended from the Tribe of Simeon, and he prophesied in about the year 650 B.C. The Prophet Habakkuk foresaw the destruction of the Jerusalem Temple, the Babylonian Captivity and the later return of the captives to their native-land. During the time of the war with the Babylonians the prophet withdrew to Arabia, where with him there occurred the following miracle. When he was bringing dinner to the reapers, he met with an Angel of the Lord, and instantly by the strength of his spirit he was transported to Babylon, where at the time the Prophet Daniel was languishing in prison. Thus, the food, intended for the reapers, assuaged the hunger of the exhausted Prophet Daniel. After the end of the war with the Babylonians, the Prophet Habakkuk returned to his fatherland and died in extreme old age. His relics were found at the time of the holy Constantinople Emperor Theodosius he Younger (408-450).
