Excerpt from Christ Our Pascha

Reading and Explanation of Holy Scripture

Following the tradition of the Holy Fathers of the Church, Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky refers to the holy Scriptures as an infinite and unfathomable ocean of truth and goodness:

Holy Scripture is the word of God Most High, one in the Trinity, spoken to us useless sinners, whom the Most High calls to the dignity of being his children and receives us as his children. It is therefore an inexhaustible treasury of all heavenly blessings, a source of the light of heavenly, infallible truth, and of living water, flowing unto eternal life and the eternal salvation of the whole human race. And so, let us come to understand what medicine for the soul, what angelic nourishment, what strength for life, and what a most wonderful gift from heaven is every word of holy scripture. (#49)

## His Beatitude Sviatoslav's Greetings for Easter

On this bright day of the Feast of Christ's Resurrection, let me heartily greet all of you, wherever you arein Ukraine or abroad, in a family circle, or perhaps far from your home. We celebrate this holiday together, because Christ is risen!" addressed His Beatitude Sviatoslav to all the believers. "On this day there are absolutely new circumstances for the life of the universe, because Jesus Christ triumphantly emerges from a sealed tomb. He rises as the Sun of Truth, which is the source of life and resurrection, the source of our hope. It is the light of our life, because it illuminates our life path," added the Primate of the Church. He also assured that the Lord gives strength and hope to each and every one of us to overcome difficulties. "If Christ is resurrected, everything around us gets a new meaning. After all, if there is a way out of a sealed coffin, which was guarded by troops and closed with a heavy stone, then we have hope, too. The Son of God today invites each of us at the time of the resurrection to also meet ourselves: our personal life situation, and to rethink the difficulties, problems, and sorrows that surround us. For it is in the grave of the risen Christ that tears change sadness for joy, for hope. May this holiday be a holy change for each of us, for every human heart, as well as a holiday of hope for our long-suffering Ukrainian people," underlined the spiritual leader of the Greek Catholics. "I wish you all blessed Easter holidays, tasty Easter eggs, and joyful hajivky. Let's rejoice in the Resurrection of Christ, because it is our life and resurrection, too. Christ is risen! Truly, He is risen!" His Beatitude Sviatoslav greeted all believers .
